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**THE ROLE OF AXIOLOGICAL APPROACHES IN ENHANCING HUMANISTIC VALUES  
AMONG UNIVERSITY STUDENTS: PEDAGOGICAL PERSPECTIVES**

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**Annotation:** This article analyzes the pedagogical potential of axiological approaches in enhancing humanistic values among university students. **Annotatsiya:** Maqolada oliy ta’lim muassasalari talabalari orasida insonparvarlik qadriyatlarini shakllantirish va mustahkamlashda aksiologik yondashuvlarning pedagogik imkoniyatlari tahlil qilinadi.
